





1. Pre-Installation Precautions

- (a) Park vehicle on a flat surface. Position the gear lever in P.
- (b) Engage Parking Brake.

2. Remove OE Shift Knob

(a) Turn the OE shift knob counter-clockwise to loosen, then remove and discard. (Fig. 2-1)

3. Install TRD Shift Knob

(a) Lower TRD Shift Knob onto shaft, apply downward pressure and turn clockwise about 15 times until snug. (Fig. 3-1)



NOTE: DO NOT over-tighten! Damage to Inner Sleeve may occur.



NOTE: Be careful when turning shift knob to avoid mis-threading.

(b) Adjust TRD Shift Knob so the logo on top of knob is aligned with the front seats.(Fig. 3-2)

NOTE: The shift knob can become extremely hot when the vehicle is parked under direct sunlight. Please be mindful of this and take necessary precautions.
