- · Bumper fascia trimming required
- · Temporary underbody panel removal

Periodic inspection of the trailer hitch should be performed to ensure all mounting hardware remains tight and structural components are secure.

To help prevent damage to the product or vehicle, refer to the specified torque specifications when securing hardware during the installation process.






Product Registration and Warranty

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ASSEMBLY







Step 1


Remove the underbody panel from the rear of the vehicle by removing eleven push fasteners and three nuts using a 10mm socket with 3" extension.





Step 2

Trim the bumper cover using the trim diagram for reference.



Step 3

Raise the hitch into position, gently pulling down on the bumper cover to allow the hitch to slide into place and secure with M12 hardware. Torque M12 hardware to 86 ft-lbs.

Reinstall the underbody panel removed in step 1.
